ACTIVITIES TO DO AT HOME

Start a vegie garden with your children, it is the perfect time and weather to do so! Children can benefit and learn a lot by being involved in gardening experiences. Children become more responsible for growing and looking after their own fruits and vegetables as well as learning about healthy eating. Being outdoors and gardening helps improve children's cognitive and motor skills.

Start off by choosing the right location in your garden. (Try and find a sunny spot) Now its time to choose vegetables/fruits that are easy to grow, these include: carrots, tomatoes, and strawberries!

- 1. Create a garden bed, or use a planter box
- 2. Fill with soil and fertiliser
- 3. Plant the seeds in the soil
- 4. Water them daily until ready to harvest
- 5. Enjoy your home grown vegetables/fruit!





Is your child enrolled in or attending another service?

Please let us know if your child is attending any other Family Day Care, Kinder or Childcare service, or receiving NDIS funding. This is to ensure that booking timings are not being mixed up or overlapping, as children can only be at one service at a time. This is to make sure that families are paying a lower parent gap fee and not exceeding their CCS hours to avoid paying the full fee.

INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR CHILDCARE SUBSIDY

We are now changing our invoicing over to Central Payments. We would like to confirm that this is **not** a direct debit system, however this means that invoices will be sent from Dynamic Kids Family Day Care to families, rather than from the educators to families.

We would also like to mention that as of August 13th, the government has offered support for families who are keeping their children at home during the lockdown. Early Childhood Education and Care services can support families during this time, by waiving the parent gap fee. The parent gap fee is waived for families who are <u>absent</u> during this lockdown period, therefore parents will not be charged this gap fee.

The government has also allowed Early Childhood Education and Care services to access additional allowable absences if the lockdown extends for more than seven days. If the hotspot declaration extends for more than seven days, the Child Care Subsidy System will automatically assess any absences claimed during that period as emergency additional absences and backdate those absences as required.

EDUCATOR MONTHLY TRAINING

At Dynamic Kids Family Day Care, our aim is to always provide support and upskill our educators. During this lockdown, we have been providing monthly educator trainings online with a Focus Of The Month (FOM) topic to discuss. Our previous months topic was 'Quality Area 3 – Physical Environment', in this training we discussed ways to make the physical environment more safe, welcoming, and sustainable, as well as discussing the maintenance and upkeep of resources.

Over this month, the educators are receiving training in transitioning to electronic program planning. Our educators will be uploading monthly programs, monthly observations, and daily diaries to communicate with families through the Harmony app. This is a much more sustainable approach to program planning, as well as giving families the comfort of viewing children's photos, observations and learning stories daily from their mobile phones.

Attention Families: Families will be receiving an email from Harmony, so please keep an eye on your email. This will have your username and password for your Harmony account, through this you will be able to access the parent portal and view your child's program, observations, and daily diary.





ONLINE LEARNING SUPPORT

Our educators have been working hard to support families through the lockdown via zoom or video calls to engage with children by providing learning activities at home. Feel free to contact your child/ren's educators to arrange a zoom session or video call for the following activities:

- Group virtual play date
- Show and tell session
- Group time with stories or songs
- Music and movement session

Please do not hesitate to contact educators, co-ordinators, or office staff as they are available to offer emotional support to families and children who are impacted by this lockdown.
